Catholics Must Not Be in Religious Communion with Bad Catholics and in Secular Communion if Possible

Bad Catholics are obstinate mortal sinners, and thus they have no firm purpose of amendment. They are under an automatic minor excommunication. A Catholic who commits mortal sin and sincerely confesses it has a firm purpose of amendment and thus is not a bad Catholic. St. Paul teaches that Catholics must not be in religious with bad Catholics and not be in secular communion with them if possible.

“But now I have written to you, not to keep company if any man that is named a brother [Catholics and nominal Catholics], be a fornicator, or covetous, or a server of idols, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such a one, not so much as to eat.” (1 Cor. 5:11)

“We charge you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you withdraw yourselves from every brother walking disorderly and not according to the tradition which they have received of us.” (2 Thes. 3:6)

“A little leaven corrupteth the whole lump?” (1 Cor. 5:6)

The Bond of Charity, Unity, and Peace among Good Catholics

“By this shall all men know that you are my disciples, if you have love one for another.” (Jn. 13:35)

“Behold how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity.” (Ps. 132:1)

“Be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, being lovers of the brotherhood, merciful, modest, humble.” (1 Pt. 3:8)

God’s Church Has a Hierarchy

“Take heed to yourselves and to the whole flock, wherein the Holy Spirit hath placed you bishops to rule the Church of God.” (Acts 20:28)

Justified Slavery
