## William Norris' Report on the TorC School Board Meeting (3-13-2023)

On 3/13/23, Br Nick and I went to a Truth or Consequences School Board Meeting. They have them every month on the second 2<sup>nd</sup> Weekday. The reason for going to this one was to protest the new curriculum of books that they want to implement for the Kindergarten to 12th grade in the Truth or Consequences School District. The two sets of curriculums consisted of Savvas and McGraw Hill. Prior to the meeting, Br. Phil and I had gone to the Truth or Consequences Schools District Administration building twice to review these materials. We mainly focused on the Social Study aspect of the curriculum. The reason for this is because that the Public Education Department of New Mexico had recently approved 128 new Social Study standards to be implemented into the new curriculum.

The public was given to 3/10/23 look at these books and fill out evaluation forms to state whether or not you liked the new curriculum of the books.
